Discussion was held regarding property owned and sold by Ms. Anjanette Hebert. It was questioned if she was in violation of the subdivision ordinance for property sold in 2007 and if she could proceed with the sale of additional property.

The opinion of Mr. Brad Andrus, Parish Attorney, is that due to intent, interpretation, and circumstances, Ms. Hebert is not in violation of the ordinance.

President David Savoy stated that regardless of intent it still violated the Subdivision Ordinance.

Mr. Joey Savoie, Planning Commission Member, stated that according to our ordinance a subdivision is defined as any division of land into 5 lots or more with any one of which being less than 3 acres.

Ms. Anjanette Hebert addressed the Police Jury and requested a waiver for the violation to the Subdivision Ordinance and permission to sale the additional 10 acres as one tract of land.

A motion was offered by Mr. A. J. Broussard, seconded by Mrs. Julie Borill and carried, to deny the request of Ms. Anjanette Hebert for a waiver to the Subdivision Ordinance.

Ms. Hebert asked the Police Jury what would be the next course of action since the waiver was denied.

The Jury stated that she would need to develop a subdivision and bring it to the Planning Commission for approval.

A motion was offered by Mr. Robert Guidry, seconded by Mr. Jimmie Pellerin and carried, to authorize the President to execute Change Order #1 for the repairs to Vie Terre Beau Bridge Repair Project in the amount of One Hundred Forty-Eight Thousand Nine Hundred Fourteen and 00/100 (\$148,914.00) Dollars added to the original contract price for an adjusted contract price of Two Hundred Seventy-Four Thousand Nine Hundred Fourteen and 00/100 (\$274,914.00) Dollars with the mobilization charge not to exceed \$2,500.00.

A motion was offered by Mr. Robert Guidry, seconded by Mrs. Julie Borill and carried, to accept the final plat of Mire Estates, LLC.
