The meeting was called to order by Mr. Jason Gossen, Chairman.

A motion was offered by Ms. Catherine Lacombe, seconded by Mr. Joey Savoie and carried, to approve the minutes of the October 20, 2015 Meeting as amended.

Mr. Karl Aucoin, Parish Engineer, reviewed the final plans of BG Estates.

A motion was offered by Ms. Catherine Lacombe, seconded by Mr. Pat Daigle and carried, approve BG Estates' construction plans subject to the comments of the Parish Engineer's review being addressed.

Mr. Michael Leger, resident of Rue Novembre, asked what a cross drain was and what other drainage proposed drainage was along the development. Stated that he has an issue with trespassing. He stated that the new culvert was installed and the old culvert along with other trash was placed on his mother-in-law's property by the developer.

Ms. Kathleen Mire, resident of Rue Novembre, questioned if the hydraulic study ordered by the Police Jury had been conducted and stated that on October 19, 2015 there were some issues and some things were buried on the property.

Mr. Don Chamblee, resident of Rue Novembre, stated that the developer was under investigation by the State Fire Marshall's Office and possibly the Department of Environmental Quality as well.

Mr. Jason Gossen stated that environmental testing was not addressed in the Subdivision Ordinance.
