Mr. Ron Lawson, Third Party Provider, addressed the Committee and requested that changes be made to the procedures for permitting a building with preexisting structures or foundations. He stated that when an inspection is performed for building permits that have preexisting structures or foundations there is no way of knowing if the preexisting structure or foundation is built to code. He recommended that applicants be required to sign an affidavit releasing the Acadia Parish Police Jury and all building code officials from any liability should the preexisting structure or foundation not be built to code.

A motion was offered by Mr. A. J. Credeur, seconded by Mr. Alton Stevenson and carried, to instruct Ron Lawson, Lee Hebert, and the Parish Attorney to draft an affidavit and present it at the next Regular Police Jury Meeting.

The Road and Bridge Committee of the Acadia Parish Police Jury met following the Personnel Committee on Wednesday, November 5, 2014, in the Police Jury Meeting Room. Present was Mr. Dale Trahan, Chairperson, Mrs. Julie Borill, and Mr. Robert Guidry.

A motion was offered by Mrs. Julie Borill, seconded by Mr. Dale Trahan and carried, to add the following items to the agenda:

1. Request from Fred Heinen regarding assistance for the installation of culverts at the Mowata Church.
2. Discuss procedures for changing road names and abandoning roads. (Mrs. Mary Richard)
3. Authorize the calling of a public hearing for a 15 MPH Speed Limit on Rue Jean and Beth Road.
4. Discuss, with possible action, damage and repairs to Forest Drive.

Discussion was held regarding entering into an agreement with the City of Crowley to resurface a portion of Standard Mill Road.

A motion was offered by Mr. Dale Trahan, seconded by Mr. Robert Guidry and carried, to table this item until the next Regular Police Jury Meeting and request the Mayor of Crowley to attend. Mrs. Julie Borill opposed.

A motion was offered by Mrs. Julie Borill, seconded by Mr. Dale Trahan and carried, to recommend that the Police Jury authorize the Parish Road Manager to provide assistance to the Mowata Church for the installation of culverts.

Ms. Mary Richard addressed the Committee regarding procedures for the change of road names and for the abandonment of roads in Acadia Parish. She stated that there is a lot of time and cost involved when changing a road name or abandoning a road and requested that the Police Jury amend their procedure.

Juror A. J. Credeur suggested that when a road name is changed that the old name sign remain and the new sign be installed for 60 days before removing the old name sign.

A motion was offered by Mrs. Julie Borill, seconded by Mr. Robert Guidry and carried, to recommend that the Police Jury Authorize the calling of a public hearing for a 15 MPH Speed Limit on Rue Jean and Beth Road.

Discussion was held regarding damage and repairs to Forest Drive.

A motion was offered by Mrs. Julie Borill, seconded by Mr. Dale Trahan and carried, to table this item until the next Regular Police Jury Meeting.
