**RESOLUTION**

**WHEREAS**, the voters of Acadia Parish have supported a referendum to allow video poker gaming in Acadia Parish.

**WHEREAS**, there are 8 Truck stops located in the boundaries of Acadia Parish that are operating a video poker casino in the facilities.

**WHEREAS**, the Parish of Acadia receives tax revenue from the ad valorem tax, sales tax and a percentage of the video poker take that has and is providing services to the people of Acadia Parish.

**WHEREAS**, the State of Louisiana's Legislature has imposed a law Revised Statute 27:422 that would prevent any further Video Poker Truck Stops from operating within one mile from certain properties, including residential property.

**WHEREAS**, the 9 Truck Stops in Acadia Parish are much less than one mile from the nearest resident.

**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Acadia Parish Police Jury in special session duly convened on this the 26<sup>th</sup> day of February, 2014, does hereby request the State of Louisiana to exempt Acadia Parish from Revised Statute 27:422.
