A motion was offered by Mr. David Savoy, seconded by Mr. Robert Guidry and carried, to recommend that the Police Jury authorize the President to sign Change Order No. 1 (Final) for the hardsurfacing of Charles Houssiere Road and Arthur Latreille Road for an approximate credit of \$1,862.80.

A motion was offered by Mr. David Savoy, seconded by Mr. Robert Guidry and carried, to recommend that the Police Jury authorize the President to sign Partial Payment Request No. 1 for the hardsurfacing of Charles Houssiere Road and Arthur Latreille Road in the amount of \$61,998.48.
