

A public hearing was held in the Police Jury Meeting Room, Courthouse Building, Crowley, Louisiana, on at 6:30 P.M., on Tuesday, May 12, 2015, in the Police Jury Meeting Room, Courthouse Building, Crowley, to receive comments on the setting of a Five (5) Ton Weight Limit on Forest Drive.

Juror Dale Trahan inquired if a Five (5) Ton Weight Limit on Forest Drive would be enough.

Juror Robert Guidry stated that despite recent repairs to the road the damage to the road was caused by the hauling of dirt for a house pad and when the cement trucks go down the road to build the house pad the road would be damaged again.

Mr. Brad Andrus, Parish Attorney, stated that by Ordinance whomever travels a parish road and exceeds a certain weight must get a permit from the Police Jury and if they damage the road they are responsible for repairs. If they do not receive a permit then they shall be fined \$500.00 and the cost of repairs to the road.

Juror A. J. Credeur inquired into how the Ordinance would be policed.
