

The Acadia Parish Planning Commission held a regular meeting on Tuesday, May 20, 2014 at 4:30 P.M. in the Acadia Parish Police Jury Administrative Building, Conference Room, 505 NE Court Circle, Crowley, Louisiana with Mr. Jason Gossen presiding.

The meeting was called to order by Mr. Jason Gossen, Chairman.

A motion was offered by Ms. Mary Richard, seconded by Ms. Catherine Lacombe and carried, to revise the agenda to change items 5 and 6 to items 4 and 5 and move item 4 to item 6.

A motion was offered by Ms. Mary Richard, seconded by Mr. Joey Savoie and carried, to approve the minutes of the meeting held April 15, 2014 as written.

A motion was offered by Mr. Joey Savoie, seconded by Mr. Pat Daigle and carried, to accept the preliminary/final plat of subdivision to be developed by Hillman Meche.

A motion was offered by Ms. Catherine Lacombe, seconded by Mr. Pat Daigle and carried, to accept the preliminary plat of Saint Haven Mobile Home Park to be developed by Steven Broussard and to request that the Police Jury review and address drainage issues near proposed mobile home park.

Mr. Isaac Patin, resident of Acadia Parish, stated that the area surrounding the proposed mobile home park often had standing water for a week following a heavy rain.

A motion was offered by Mr. Pat Daigle, seconded by Mr. Joey Savoie and carried, to accept the preliminary/final plat of Gents Cove Subdivision to be developed by Mike Johnson contingent upon receipt of letter from Sanitarian approving sewage and letter from water company indicating capacity and willingness to supply water to proposed subdivision. It was also recommended that he remove the drainage servitudes in between lots from plat or indicate that they are private.

Mr. Wayne Hollier addressed the Planning Commission regarding the procedures to developing a mobile home park.

There being no further business to come before the Commission, the meeting was adjourned until the next regular meeting.
