A motion was offered by Mr. Kerry Kilgore, seconded by Mr. Richard Faul and carried unanimously, to remove item #7 from the agenda.

Discussion was held regarding the proposed agreement with the LA DOTD and Acadiana Planning Commission for the LA1112-LA 13 (Bayou Plaquemine Road) Road Transfer right sizing credits.

Mr. William Nevitt, resident of Crowley, LA, stated that by accepting Highway 1112 into the parish road system the Police Jury would be responsible for maintenance of that road and would receive state funds to do so. He further stated that those funds could be used for the repair of other roads in the parish and suggested that the Police Jury select a project other than the proposed repair and widening of Holland/Indigo/Morrow Road. He further stated that because these roads are prone to flooding it would be a waste of funds.

**SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED** by the Police Jury of Acadia Parish, Louisiana, that it shall be unlawful for any person to operate or drive a motor vehicle in excess of **fifteen miles per hour** on the following described Parish Road:

**ZAUNBRECHER ROAD  
(FOR 300 FEET AROUND THE CURVE IN THE VICINITY OF THE RAILROAD  
TRACKS)**

**SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED** that any person found guilty of operating or driving a motor vehicle in excess of **fifteen miles per hour** on the Parish road described above, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction therefore, shall

be fined not more than Fifty Dollars (\$50) or be imprisoned not more than ten (10) days or both.

**SECTION 3. BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED** that any laws or parts of laws in conflict are hereby repealed.

### **ORDINANCE #1108**

AN ORDINANCE MAKING IT UNLAWFUL FOR ANY PERSON TO OPERATE OR DRIVE A MOTOR VEHICLE UPON ZAUNBRECHER ROAD IN ACADIA PARISH, LOUISIANA, WITH A GROSS WEIGHT IN EXCESS OF **TWENTY (20) TONS**, AND PROVIDING FOR THE PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF.

**SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED** by the Police Jury of Acadia Parish, Louisiana, that it shall be unlawful for any person except local farmers during harvest and garbage truck drivers to operate a motor vehicle with a gross weight in excess of TWENTY (20) Tons on the following described parish road:

### **ZAUNBRECHER ROAD**

**SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED** that any person found guilty of operating or driving a motor vehicle with a gross weight exceeding **TWENTY (20) Tons** on the parish roads described above, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction therefore, shall be fined not more than Fifty Dollars (\$50) or be imprisoned not more than ten (10) days or both.

**SECTION 3. BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED** that any laws or parts of laws in conflict are hereby repealed.
