The meeting was called to order by Mr. Jason Gossen, Chairman.

A motion was offered by Mrs. Catherine Lacombe, seconded by Mr. Pat Daigle and carried, to approve the minutes of the meeting held June 17, 2014 as amended.

A motion was offered by Mr. Derek Bisig, seconded by Mr. Pat Daigle and carried, to accept the construction plans for Saint Haven Mobile Home Park contingent upon issues stated in Engineer's Letter of Review being addressed.

Discussion was held regarding drainage for Mire Estates Mobile Home Park. There was concern regarding drainage and flood issues near and on the proposed location.

A motion was offered by Mr. Joey Savoie, seconded by Ms. Catherine Lacombe and carried, to accept the preliminary plat for Mire Estates Mobile Home Park contingent upon receipt of letter of concurrence from Sanitarians, receipt of letter of perpetual maintenance from drainage board and any other issues stated in Engineer's Letter of Review being addressed.
