Discussion was held regarding proposed Change Order No. 1 for Repairs for the Vie Terre Beau Bridge at Bayou Nezpique Project.

Mr. Beau Tate, Royal Engineering, addressed the Police Jury and stated that following an inspection of the bridge it was determined that approximately thirty (30) timber piles and two pile caps needed to be replaced. He recommended that the damaged bridge members be removed and replaced. The proposed change order would be an additional One Hundred Sixty-Two Thousand Eight Hundred Eighty-Six and 69/100 (\$162,886.69) Dollars added to the original contract price for an adjusted contract price of Two Hundred Eighty-Eight Thousand Eight Hundred Eighty-Six and 69/100 (\$288,886.69) Dollars.

The Police Jurors expressed concern over the labor costs on the proposed change order, where the additional funding would come from, and why an inspection prior to the start of the project did not show the damaged bridge members. It was questioned if replacing the entire bridge would be more cost efficient and last longer.

A motion was offered by Mr. Robert Guidry, seconded by Mr. Jimmie Pellerin and carried, to authorize the advertisement of bids for the replacement of and bids for the repairing of Vie Terre Beau Bridge and to instruct the Secretary-Treasurer to contact FEMA to find out if the funding they are providing can be used towards the replacement of instead of repairs to the Vie Terre Beau Bridge.

THERE BEING NO FURTHER BUSINESS TO COME BEFORE THE MEETING, THE MOTION WAS OFFERED DULY SECONDED, THAT THE MEETING ADJOURN UNTIL NEXT REGULARLY SCHEDULED MEETING ON OCTOBER 14, 2014, AT THE HOUR OF 6:30 P. M.
