

The Building and Grounds Committee of the Acadia Parish Police Jury met at 6:00 P.M. on Tuesday, April 13, 2010, in the Police Jury Meeting Room. Present were Messrs. John Quebodeaux, Chairman and Alton Stevenson. Absent was Felton Moreau.

A motion was offered by Mr. Alton Stevenson, seconded by Mr. John Quebodeaux and carried, that the Police Jury authorize the electrical engineer, Darrell Hicks, to prepare plans and specifications and receive proposals for electrical work to be done at the Acadia Parish Courthouse and the Old Jail facility.

The Committee reviewed proposals that had been submitted for Parish wide generator hook-ups. The proposals submitted were as follows: Guidry's Electrical in the amount of \$10,750.00, Prevost Electrical in the amount of \$13,250.00, and Triple T in the amount of \$7,710.75. H&H Electrical submitted an incomplete proposal.

A motion was offered by Mr. Alton Stevenson, seconded by Mr. John Quebodeaux and carried, that the Police Jury accept the proposal of Triple T in the amount of \$7,710.75.
