A resolution approving the issuance, sale and delivery of not exceeding \$225,000 of Certificates of Indebtedness, Series 2013, of Fire Protection District No.7 of the Parish of Acadia, State of Louisiana.

WHEREAS, Fire Protection District No.7 of the Parish of Acadia, State of Louisiana (the "District"), proposes to issue not exceeding \$225,000 of Certificates of Indebtedness, Series 2013 (the "Certificates"), to pay costs of acquiring and equipping a fire truck for the Issuer and pay costs of issuance; and

WHEREAS, the District has requested that this Police Jury approve the issuance, sale and delivery of the Certificates; and

WHEREAS, as required by Article VI, Section 15 of the Constitution of the State of Louisiana of 1974, it is now the desire of this Police Jury to approve the issuance of the Certificates;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Police Jury of the Parish of Acadia, State of Louisiana, acting as the governing authority of the Parish of Acadia, State of Louisiana, that:

SECTION 1. In compliance with the provisions of Article VI, Section 15 of the Constitution of the State of Louisiana of 1974, and in accordance with the request of the Board of Commissioners of Fire Protection District No.7 of the Parish of Acadia, State of Louisiana, this Police Jury hereby approves the issuance, sale and delivery of not exceeding \$225,000 of Certificates of Indebtedness of said District in accordance with a resolution adopted by the Board of Commissioners of said District on May 13,

2013. The Certificates will be secured by and payable from a pledge of the excess of annual revenues of said District above statutory, necessary and usual charges in each of the fiscal years during which the Certificates are outstanding, and neither the Parish of Acadia nor this Police Jury shall be liable in any manner for the payment of principal and/or interest on the Certificates.
