

It was announced by the Chairman that notice had been given that the Acadia Parish Planning Commission would conduct a public hearing on Tuesday, July 15, 2014 at 4:30 P.M., in the Police Jury Meeting Room, Courthouse Building, Crowley, Louisiana, to receive comments on the following proposed mobile home park development:

MIRE ESTATES TO BE DEVELOPED BY MIRE ESTATES, LLC, 3.719 ACRE TRACT OF LAND DIVIDED INTO 9 LOTS, SITUATED IN SECTION 5, TOWNSHIP 9 SOUTH, RANGE 3 EAST, ACADIA PARISH, LOUISIANA

Ms. Jeanette Thibodeaux, resident of Fire Station Lane in Acadia Parish, Louisiana, had several questions regarding the proposed Mobile Home Park. She asked if the development was a subdivision or mobile home park. She stated that her main concern was flooding in the area because the drainage was poor. She asked what type of sewage system was going to be in place. She asked the difference between a drainage ditch and swale ditch. She asked if the road and ditches were public or private.

Mr. Ryan Hebert, representative of Mire Estates, LLC, stated that the development was a mobile home park, that the sewage would be individual plants, that the difference between a drainage ditch and swale ditch was that drainage ditches have culverts and swale ditches have a gradual slope and no culverts, and that the road and ditches would be private.
