

A public hearing was held in the Police Jury Meeting Room, Courthouse Building, Crowley, Louisiana, on Tuesday, March 12, 2013, at 6:00 P.M. to receive comments on the proposed amendment to the Acadia Parish Hurricanes Gustav and Ike Application Recovery Proposal required by the Louisiana Recovery Authority.

Mr. Danny Magee stated that there were excess CDBG Gustav and Ike Disaster Recovery Program funds available and that it would need to be determined which projects would be elevated from alternate status to primary status.

Discussion was held regarding using some of the excess funds towards the hangar project at LeGros Memorial Airport.

Mr. David Hidalgo reviewed the costs of using pilings and the cost of using post-tension slabs for the hangar project at the LeGros Memorial Airport. It was decided that post-tension slabs should be used instead of pilings on the hangar project.

Discussion was held regarding the alternate projects that could be elevated to primary status. It was recommended that the excess funding be used to elevate the Church Point Generator Project to primary status contingent upon Church Point providing the additional funding needed to complete the project. In the event that Church Point does not provide the additional funding, the Morse Street Improvements Project would be elevated to primary status instead.
