EDGEWOOD II SUBDIVISION TO BE DEVELOPED BY HILLMAN MECHE, 6.657 ACRE TRACT OF LAND DIVIDED INTO 7 LOTS, SITUATED IN SECTION 31, TOWNSHIP 8 SOUTH, RANGE 3 EAST, ACADIA PARISH, LOUISIANA

and

SAINT HAVEN MOBILE HOME PARK TO BE DEVELOPED BY STEVEN BROUSSARD, 8.961 ACRE TRACT OF LAND DIVIDED INTO 40 LOTS, SITUATED IN SECTION 3, TOWNSHIP 9 SOUTH, RANGE 3 EAST, ACADIA PARISH, LOUISIANA
