Comments from those present were invited and information was provided informing those in attendance of the following:

1. Amount of funds available for proposed community development and housing activities.
2. Range of activities available that may be undertaken, including the estimated amount of funds proposed to be used for activities that will benefit persons of low and moderate income.
3. Plans of Acadia Parish for minimizing displaced persons as a result of activities assisted with such funds and the benefits to be provided by Acadia Parish to persons actually displaced as a result of such activities.
4. Acadia Parish past performance on LCDBG projects funded by the State of Louisiana.

Discussion was held regarding a possible substation off of Lovell Street for the proposed new fire district.
