WHEREAS, the Office of Community Development has made available funding that will assist local governments impacted by Hurricane Gustav/Ike in completing construction/renovation projects with costs that are FEMA-reimbursement ineligible, **and**

WHEREAS, the Acadia Parish Police Jury is currently preparing to construct Crowley Sewer Generator No. 1, which is not eligible for FEMA reimbursement, **and**

WHEREAS, the proposed construction project at this point is one of "urgent need" due to the fact that the Acadia Parish Police Jury does not have sufficient local funds to finance the proposed costs of the project and the completion of the project is necessary to protect the health and safety of the citizens.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Acadia Parish Police Jury in regular session duly convened on this the 10th day of November, 2010, does hereby request approval to use CDBG funds in the construction of Crowley Sewer Generator No. 1, thereby maximizing benefits to the community through recovery efforts.
