ORDINANCE #1013

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE ACADIA PARISH CODE OF ORDINANCES.

WHEREAS, the Acadia Parish Police Jury determined that under the 2010 Census, the current single-member election districts for the members of the Acadia Parish Police Jury were malapportioned, and:

WHEREAS, the Acadia Parish Police Jury developed a new election plan labeled Plan 2A for the members of the Acadia Parish Police Jury that was in fulfillment of the requirements of the U.S. Department of Justice under Section 5 of the Voting Rights Act, the requirements of the State of Louisiana and the Louisiana Secretary of State, and:

WHEREAS, the new election plan is hereby designated as the Redistricting Plan, and

WHEREAS, the precinct splits contained in the Redistricting Plan meet the requirements for splitting precincts as promulgated by the State of Louisiana such as but not limited to using census tabulation blocks that contain visible features for split precinct boundaries;

Beginning at the junction of Teddy Street and its junction with the center of Bayou Plaquemine Brule, thence proceeding in a northwesterly direction on the center of Bayou Plaquemine Brule to its junction with the center of the westbound lanes of Interstate 10, thence proceeding easterly on the westbound lanes of Interstate 10 to its junction with the center of a creek, thence proceeding in a northerly direction on the center of said creek to its junction with the center of (PR 6-1) North Cherokee Drive, thence proceeding in an easterly, thence northerly direction on the center of North Cherokee Drive to its junction with the center of (PR 6-2) Teddy Street, thence proceeding in an easterly, thence northerly direction on the center of Teddy Street to its junction with the center of Bayou Plaquemine Brule, which is point of beginning.

The Ordinance was offered by Mr. John Quebodeaux, and seconded by Mr. Kermit Richard, after being read and considered section by section and having been published in accordance with law and having been heard in a public hearing in Crowley, Louisiana on the 11th day of May, 2011 was adopted by the following vote on this the 25th day of May, 2011.

ADOPTION OF REAPPORTIONMENT PLAN 2A

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 830, REAPPORTIONING SINGLE MEMBER VOTING DISTRICTS FOR THE ACADIA PARISH POLICE JURY, LOUISIANA, IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE 2010 CENSUS

WHEREAS, on May 25, 2011, the Acadia Parish Police Jury Council adopted Plan 2A as it's reapportionment Plan based upon the 2010 census; and

WHEREAS, Plan 2A is hereby designated at the Redistricting Plan, and
