The Acadia Parish Sanitary Landfill resumes the policy requiring the inspection/permitting of all commercial roll-off and contractor loads

MEDIA ALERT: Effective July 10, 2023, all commercial roll-off and contractor loads must be inspected by the Landfill Waste Inspection Officer prior to being allowed entry into the facility. All loads must be inspected at the point of waste generation. Call (337) 250-8845 to schedule an inspection.

As per the landfill's solid waste permit and tax propositions passed by the citizens of Acadia Parish, only waste generated within the limits of Acadia Parish are allowed to be disposed at their landfill. There are no tipping fees. A landfill with no tipping fees may be tempting to those outside of Acadia Parish who otherwise pay tipping fees to dispose elsewhere. The inspection and permitting process helps to minimize illegal waste entering the Acadia Parish Sanitary Landfill from other parishes. The officer will inspect the waste at the point of generation, confirm the type and quantity of waste, and provide documentation that must be presented at the landfill. Loads that arrive without such documentation shall be rejected. Those that violate, attempt to violate, or aid or attempt to aid someone to violate this policy shall be subject to fines.
