A motion was offered by Troy Lantz and seconded by Pat Daigle for the nomination of Dr. Ezora Proctor.

A motion was offered by Kirk Guidry and seconded by Paul Guidry to adopt a resolution proclaiming a special election to fill the vacancy in the office of Police Juror for District 1.

PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, the Honorable Walter Andrus, Police Juror for District 1 of Acadia Parish, Louisiana died on December 8, 2025; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Louisiana R. S. 18:602 (A), the Acadia Parish Police Jury has the obligation within twenty days of the seat becoming vacant, to issue a proclamation for a Special Election to fill the vacant seat;

Now therefore be it Resolved that the Acadia Parish Police Jury issues this Proclamation calling for a Special Election in which the electors of District 1 of Acadia Parish, Louisiana, will elect a Police Jury for District 1 of Acadia Parish, Louisiana.

And be it further Resolved that the Acadia Parish Police Jury forward this request to the Honorable Laura Faul, Acadia Parish Clerk of Court, to have her execute the necessary process to carry out this election on the nearest available election day in Acadia Parish, with qualifying on February 11, 12 and 13; Primary Election on May 16, 2025 and Runoff Election on June 27, 2025.

Judge Scott Privat swore in Dr. Ezora Proctor.
