

**The Acadia Parish Planning Commission held a Regular Meeting on Tuesday, June 17, 2025, in the Police Jury Meeting Room, Courthouse Building, Crowley, LA. Jason Gossen presided over the meeting.**

The meeting was called to order by Jason Gossen.

There are two agenda item amendments requested.

A motion was made by Chris Huesers and seconded by Mary Richard and carried unanimously to amend the agenda to include an item to discuss adding a 9<sup>th</sup> member to the Planning Commission.

A motion was made by Chris Huesers and seconded by Mary Richard to amend the agenda to include an item to discuss setting up additional meetings to discuss amending a subdivision ordinance. Joey Savoie abstained.

A motion was made by Tracy Young and seconded by Chris Huesers and carried unanimously to dispense with the reading and approval of the minutes of the February 11, 2025, meeting as written.

Mary Richard nominated Jason Gossen as the President. Chris Huesers seconded the motion to nominate Jason Gossen as President.

The Planning Commission discussed that the President and Vice President should be voted on every year in January. Jason Gossen will be the President for the rest of 2025 and a new president and vice president will be appointed in January 2026.

A motion was offered by Tracy Young and seconded by Mary Richard and carried unanimously to vote on a president and vice president every January for that calendar year.

A motion was made by Mary Richard and seconded by Tracy Young to close the nomination for President.

Mary Richard nominated Chris Huesers as the Vice President. Tracy Young seconded the motion to nominate Chris Huesers as Vice President.

A motion was made by Mary Richard and seconded by Tracy Young to close the nomination for Vice President.

A discussion was held regarding adding a 9<sup>th</sup> member to the Planning Commission. It was discussed to reach out to the Acadia Parish Permit Office to see if any of the employees would be interested in joining the Planning Commission because they are the main point of contact for permitting. It was also discussed to reach out to each Acadia Parish Police Juror to see if they know anyone interested in being the 9<sup>th</sup> member.

A discussion was held regarding setting up additional meetings to amend the subdivision ordinance. Mr. Gossen suggested getting approval from the Acadia Parish Police Jury to request Karl Aucoin, Engineer for Acadia Parish, to look over the current ordinance and make the proposed amendments. Mr. Glen Howie, Acadia Parish Police Jury Attorney, stated he is also looking into the proposed amendments of the subdivision ordinance.

A discussion was held by Glen Howie, Acadia Parish Police Jury Attorney, regarding approving a variance for Ordinance No. 761 for the Zaunbrecher succession property. Mr. Howie explained the Police Jury will be calling for a Public Hearing in July to amend Ordinance No. 761.

A motion was offered by Tracy Young and seconded by Mary Richard and carried unanimously approving a variance for Ordinance No. 761 for the Zaunbrecher succession property.

There being no further business to come before the Commission, a motion was offered by Jason Gossen, seconded by Tracy Young and carried to adjourn the meeting until the next regularly scheduled meeting.
